This Indenture made this day of February in the Year of our Lord one
Thousand eight hundred and Twenty eight by and between Thomas C. Jones and
Martha Jones his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of
the one part and John Moore of the County State aforesaid of the other part
Witnesseth that said Thomas C. Jones and Martha Jones his wife
for and in consideration of the sum of ~~four hundred~~ dollars to them in hand
paid by the said John Moore at or before the executing and delivery of the presents
the receipt whereof they the said Thomas C. Jones and Martha Jones acknowl-
edge themselves fully satisfied contents and paid that the said granted bargain
sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell aliened
confirm with firm the said John Moore and his heirs and assigns forever
a certain Tract or Parcel of Land lying and being in the County of South-
ampton aforesaid Containing fifty acres more or less it being a part of the said
Jones's Interest in the Tract formerly belonging to his father Jones
bounded entirely by the lands of Wells Mumper James D. LaFayetteburg and the late
Edwards Tract now belonging to John T. Johnson To have and to hold
the said bargain premises with the appurtenances and advantages of all & every
kind whatsoever to him the said John Moore and his heirs and assigns forever
they the said Thomas C. Jones and Martha Jones for themselves their heirs
Executors or administrators do and well warrant and forever defend the said
bargain premises with the advantages and appurtenances of every kind
to the said Tract belonging against the lawful claims or claims of all and every
persons whatsoever to him the said John Moore and his heirs and assigns
