lars to them in hand paid on or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the said Henry
and Rebecca do hereby acknowledge that they have granted bargained and
sold aliened and confirmed unto the said John Thomas Parson and to his heirs and assigns
for ever one certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and sixty six acres more or less
situate in the parish of St. John the Baptist formerly held and possessed by Peter
Eauwas Benjamin Whitte and others containing one hundred and sixty six acres more or less
thence and to hold the said one hundred and sixty six acres land with all and singl^r what the appur-
tenances thereto belonging to the said John Thomas Parson his heirs and assigns forever
to the only proper use and behoof of them the said John Thomas Parson his heirs & assigns forever
the said Henry Parson & Rebecca doth for themselves their heirs successors and assigns
the said ~~John~~^{Henry} Parson his heirs and assigns that as the said Henry Parson and
Rebecca his wife their heirs exec^s & adm^rs shall and well warrant and forever defend them
