This Indenture made this 15th day of March 1828 between Lucy A. Collier widow of the late Thomas Collier of the one part and Thomas S. Harper of the County of Southampton of the other part witnesseth that the said Lucy A. Collier in consideration of the sum of \$250.00 secured by the bond of Benjamin C. Collier of Benjamin C. Collier & Co. payable twenty days after the 27th day of February 1828. hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto said and for ever quit claim unto said Thomas S. Harper. his heirs and assigns all manner of Dower and right and title of Dower whatsoever which she the said Lucy A. Collier now hath or of right ought to have or claim in and out of estate part or parcel of land with its appurtenances containing 300 acres lying and being in the County of Southampton and known by the name of Cross Keys being the same formerly occupied by the said Thomas Collier and now occupied by said Thomas S. Harper. and being part of the same tract of land with its appurtenances lately conveyed to said Harper by deed of Benjamin C. Collier from Charles W. Goddard as upon reference to said deed of record in the County Court of Southampton will among other things more fully appear. To have and to hold all the right title of Dower aforesaid unto the said Thomas S. Harper. his heirs and assigns free from all writ or action of Dower. whatsoever so that neither she the said Lucy A. Collier nor any other person do nor shall have or maintain any manner of Dower or right or title of Dower in and to the said aforesaid tract of land with its appurtenances or in and to any part or parcel of the same.
