from South Bay to Jerusalem Church along the said was to Eggs Hill's line thence along said Hill's line to a willow oak in Eggs Hill's line and a corner of said land thence thence straight line of marked trees to the first station and all bonds way matters profits commodities and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining done together with the reversion or reversions remainders and the rights titles interests claims or demands of the said Samuel Daughtry and Polly his wife in or to the same To have and to hold the said land and premises with the appurtenances unto her the said Polly Edwards her heirs and assigns forever and the said Samuel Daughtry and Polly his wife shall forever warrant and defend the said land and premises against the claims and demands of all persons whatsoever In Witness whereof the said Samuel Daughtry and Polly his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals this day of May first above written.
