This Indenture made this 5th day of April in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight between Henry Barrow and Rebecca his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Joseph Beland of the said County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Henry Barrow and Rebecca his wife for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars of good and lawful money of Virginia lawfully paid by the said Joseph Beland at or before the execution and delivery of this presents the receipt whereof is truly acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Joseph Beland his heirs assigns three certain Tracts or Lots of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton the first Lot containing seventy acres more or less the second Lot containing sixty six acres more or less the third Lot containing sixty four acres more or less which said Lots or parcels of Land was divided between the Orphans of Henry Barrow dec^d and adjoining the lands of the said Joseph Beland late purchase of Richard Barrow on the East and the same Henry Barrow's land on the North and William Beland's land on the West and Charles W. Goodwyn and Joseph Beland on the North & being the same known by the name of the Blake Land containing in the three Lots two hundred & acres be the same more or less to have and to hold the aforesaid Lots or parcels of Land together with all the appurtenances belonging or in anywise appertaining and all its privileges to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Joseph Beland his heirs and assigns forever and the said Henry Barrow and Rebecca his wife for themselves and their heirs the said Lots or parcels of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned or intended to have been mentioned unto the said Joseph Beland his heirs and assigns forever free from the claim or claims of him the said Henry Barrow and Rebecca his wife or either of them or their heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall well and do warrant and forever defend by these presents & the heirs of the said Henry Barrow and Rebecca his wife their heirs and assigns their heirs and assigns the day and year first above written
