 Francis Clements in and to the said hereby granted tract or parcel of land and
 promised to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and premises with its
 appurtenances together with the aforesaid Slaves and their increase and all the other
 personal property hereby conveyed unto William & Everett, his heirs, executors & assigns
 forever. And the said Francis Clements for himself his heirs executors & assigns with
 him by promise Covenant and agree to and with the said Wm & Everett, his heirs, executors
 and assigns forever, in manner and form following that is to say that the said
 Francis Clements his heirs executors and assigns the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and
 premises and appurtenances together with the aforesaid Slaves their increase and all
 the property hereby conveyed unto the said William & Everett, his heirs, executors
 and assigns against all persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and defend
 upon Trust Nevertheless that the said William & Everett, his heirs, executors and
 assigns shall permit the Francis Clements to remain in quiet possession of
 the land and property hereby conveyed and have the profits of the same to have
 and until the first day of October next and then upon further Trust that the
 said William & Everett being instructed or requested by him the said Francis
 Clements Henry & Thomas of Joseph or their heirs or Representatives shall after
 giving thirty days public notice of the time and place of sale proceed to a
 public Auction on the premises the tract or parcel of land upon and other property
 conveyed by these presents for as much money or so much thereof as shall be sufficient
 to pay the debts to Henry & Thomas and Joseph David before mentioned & the other
