wife for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and twenty Dollars of good and  
lawful money of Virginia then in hand paid by the said William Leland at or before the  
making or delivery of these presents she receipt whereof she hereby acknowledged her bargain  
and sale and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said William Leland his heirs &  
assigns one certain tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the County of Southampton  
and adjoining the land of the said William Leland John Leland and Henry Burson  
containing forty acres be the same more or less To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or  
parcel of Land together with all the appurtenances belonging or in anywise appertaining  
and all its privileges to and for the only proper use and of him the said William Leland his  
heirs and assigns forever and the said Joseph Leland and Elizabeth his wife doth for  
themselves and their heirs and assigns hereby convey the said tract or parcel of Land with all and sin-  
gular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said William Leland  
his heirs and assigns forever from the claim or claim of them the said Joseph Leland and  
Elizabeth his wife and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall well and
