This Indenture made this 4th day of April 1828. Eighteen hundred and twenty eight
Between Solomon Hurst and Mildred his wife of the one part and Jesse Morrell of the other part
all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Solomon
Hurst and Mildred his wife hath for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred &
seventy dollars to him in hand paid by the said Jesse Morrell or secured to be paid, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged and himself satisfied and paid and do therefor
quit and discharge the said Jesse Morrell his heirs and assigns forever, hath granted
bargained and sold conferred and delivered, and by these presents do grant bargain and
sell release confirm and deliver unto him the said Jesse Morrell and to his heirs and assigns
forever one certain of and containing by by estimation one hundred and fourteen & 1/2
acres be the same more or less situated lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid
and bounded as follows (To wit) Beginning at a Persimmon tree at a corner of James
Jackson's line running said line to a white oak thence the said line up the small
Branch called to a white oak corner of said land thence to a white oak a corner of said
Jackson's line then to a pine a corner of said land thence to a black gum a corner of said land
thence to a white oak a corner in Thomas Brown's land thence to a pine a corner in
James Williams' land thence to the Beginning at said persimmon
tree reference being had to the plat it will appear more fully with the reverse and
reversions of said rents and issue of the same to him the said Jesse Morrell and his heirs
forever. To have and to hold the same with ever part thereof and every the said Solomon
Hurst and Mildred his wife do by these presents warrant and forever defend the same
to the said Jesse Morrell and his heirs forever. In Witness whereof they the said
Solomon Hurst and Mildred his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day of
