This Indenture made and entered into this 19<sup>th</sup> day of April in the  
Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight Between Robert  
William and Elizabeth Gilliam his wife of the County of Southampton &  
State of Virginia of the one part and David Bryant of the said County &  
State of the other part Witness that the said Robert William & Elizabeth  
his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred & eighty one cents  
and eighty one cents to them in hand paid by the said David Bryant at and before  
the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-  
edged both parties being in and sold and by these presents doth fully & absolutely  
grant bargain and sell alien and confirm unto him & his heirs David Bryant  
his heirs & assigns one certain tract or parcel of Land lying & being in the said  
County of Southampton containing by late survey thirty four & 5/8 acres be the  
same more or less and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a pine stump  
a corner for William Bryant & James Everitt thence S. 66° 40' E. 1/2 mile to a post  
oak thence N. 17° 45' E. 36 poles thence S. 63° 45' E. 168 poles thence S. 23° 45' E. 82 poles to a pine  
thence S. 32° N. 20° to a post oak corner & thence N. 71° 12' E. 112 poles thence N. 55° 15' E. 105 poles thence  
N. 34° 10' E. 10 poles thence N. 18° 16' E. 6 poles thence N. 37° 11' 30" E. 123 poles to a pine thence N. 12°  
N. 24 poles to a post oak thence N. 11° 13' E. 13 poles to the first station together with all  
houses & buildings thereon the reversions & reversioners & remainder & premises  
rents issue & profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances  
To have and to hold the aforesaid thirty four & 5/8 acres with the appurtenances  
to him the said David Bryant his heirs & assigns & assigns to the only proper use  
& behoof of him the said David Bryant his heirs & assigns & assigns forever.  
And the said Robert William and Elizabeth his wife for them & their heirs doth by  
these presents covenant & agree to and with the said David Bryant that the said  
granted premises is free & clear from the claim or claim of any & every person or  
persons and of every incumbrance whatsoever & shall & will warrant and defend  
the same to the said David Bryant his heirs & assigns against the claim or demands of all  
and every other person or persons whatsoever.
