This Indenture made the 21st day of April One thousand eight
 hundred and twenty eight Between John Lewis acting as Trustee for Thomas
 Bond of the County of Southampton of one part and Hinchin & Burrill Williams
 of the County aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said John Lewis in
 consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to him the said John Lewis
 have paid the said Hinchin & Burrill Williams equally the receipt whereof the
 said John Lewis doth hereby acknowledge and by these presents he the said
 John Lewis further as aforesaid hath granted bargain and sold and by these
 presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Hinchin & Burrill Williams
 equally, their heirs & assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being
 in the County aforesaid on Black River in or supposed to contain two hundred and
 thirty three acres or less & adjoining the Land of John Byrnes & John Byrnes
 being the Land formerly owned by Spencer & Perkins with all the appurtenances
 thereto appertaining unto the said tract or parcel of Land whatsoever of them the said
 John Lewis as trustee as aforesaid hath given to the said tract or parcel of Land any
 part or parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with
 the appurtenances to the said Hinchin & Burrill Williams equally to them and
 assigns forever and he the said John Lewis as aforesaid his heirs & assigns doth
 covenant and agree with the said Hinchin and Burrill Williams that he will
 warrant and forever defend the right and title that is set forth in him the said
 John Lewis by Virtue of a deed of Trust executed to him by the aforesaid Thomas
 Bond on the 3rd day of April 1827 and moreover Witnesseth that the said John
 Lewis as aforesaid hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal
 the day and Year above written
