This Indenture made this 22nd of March 1828 between Henry J. Magee of the one
 part and Willie Francis of the second part and Joseph H. Land of the third part all of the
 County of Southampton and State of Virginia WITNESSETH that the said
 H. J. Magee stands justly indebted to the said Willie Francis the sum of fifteen hundred
 and twenty dollars good and lawful money due on note bearing date the 17th of March 1828
 and the said Magee being desirous to secure the said Willie Francis his debt back forth
 in consideration of the premises at also the sum of one dollar to him then and paid by
 the said Joseph H. Land granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth grant
 lawfully and sell unto the said Joseph H. Land the following property to wit horses four
 ten head of cattle sixteen head of sheep twenty four head of hogs four feather beds and
 furniture one side board one stool one Mahogany dining table one pair of cast iron
 one ironing steel one negro man named Ned two shot guns one pair of brass candlesticks
 to and for the following use and purpose that is to say the said Joseph H. Land do hereby
 shall at any time after the 18th of November next being the same to be required by the said
 Willie Francis to sell public sold for ready money giving Ten days public notice the
 above mentioned property to pay and satisfy to the said Willie Francis the amount of the
 above mentioned debt with the interest thereon as also the expenses conveying the prop-
 erty into full effect and the balance of any sum returned to him the said H. J. Magee
 his heirs & assigns WITNESSETH the 20th day of each of the parties have hereunto set their hands
 and seals the day above written

This Indenture made and entered into this 27th day of November the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and twenty three between Dremy Branch of the first part Walter H. Britton
 of the second part and John Urquhart of the third part all of the County of Southampton and
 State of Virginia WITNESSETH that the said Dremy Branch for and in consideration of the
 sum of one hundred and forty three dollars & forty four cents which said sum is due from
 the said Dremy Branch to the said John Urquhart by bond bearing date the 17th day of July
 one thousand eight hundred and twenty one as well as all other monies which may be due and owing
 from the said Dremy Branch to the said John Urquhart by means of any dealing transfer
 of debt or paper whatever as also for and in consideration one dollar then and paid by
 the said Walter H. Britton the receipt whereof the said Dremy Branch doth hereby acknowledge
 hath granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth lawfully grant bargain and sell
 convey and make over unto the said Walter H. Britton and his heirs forever all his right and interest
 in the following property to wit The plantation whereon the said Dremy Branch now resides
 bounded as follows (to wit) By the land formerly owned by John Britton due East one acre & 20th
 the lands of the same belonging to him the said Dremy Branch He have come to hold
 with all the right and interest of the said Dremy Branch therein conveyed or intended to be conveyed
 to him the said Walter H. Britton his heirs and assigns forever upon this special Trust namely
 that the said Walter H. Britton upon being directed by the said John Urquhart shall proceed
