This Indenture made this 15th day of September in the 1st year of the said one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven between Sarah he terms one of the County of Southampton of the one part and Harry he terms one of the County of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to her the said Sarah he terms in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged each bargain and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Harry he terms her legal unassigned and undivided dower in the lands of her late husband Parham he terms one as also the right to which the said Sarah he terms is entitled by the devise and bequest of her son David he terms one including all and singular her several rights in said land of what nature soever without exception In Testimony whereof the said Sarah he terms hath hereunto set her hand and seal

This Indenture made the tenth day of May in the Year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and twenty eight between Patrick Simonton & Patsy his wife and James Loggins as Trustee of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the one part & William Daughtry of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Patrick Simonton & Patsy his wife & James Loggins for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen dollars to them in hand paid by the said William Daughtry at or before the Enrolling or delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Patrick Simonton & Patsy his wife and James Loggins have granted bargain & sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said William Daughtry his heirs & assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton marked and bounded as follows Beginning at a small branch running thence South & by poles chance along said James Loggins line S 2 E 1/4 poles to the said Milton Britts line thence N 50 E 1/4 poles to the corner of said branch along said Britts line thence along the several courses of said branch to the first Station containing fifteen acres and three more or less of being the tract or parcel of Land conveyed to the said James Loggins as Trustee aforesaid for purposes therein expressed from Patrick Simonton and Patsy his wife as will appear more fully by reference to the records of Southampton County aforesaid the reversion and reversion remainders yearly and other rents issues & profits and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said William Daughtry his heirs and assigns forever And the said Patrick Simonton & Patsy his wife and James Loggins as Trustee aforesaid for himself & his heirs the said tract or parcel of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said William Daughtry his heirs and assigns free from the claim of them the said Patrick Simonton & Patsy his wife & James Loggins and his heirs and assigns and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and do warrant and forever defend by these presents In Testimony whereof the said Patrick Simonton & Patsy his wife & James Loggins have hereunto
