H. Benjamin Lewis and Samuel Drury Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Southampton to see the land of Thomas Applewhite bearing the number of 100 of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Edward H. H. Benjamin Lewis and Samuel Drury as Commissioners for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred and twenty five dollars lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Applewhite the receipt whereof they the said Edward H. H. Benjamin Lewis and Samuel Drury as Commissioners do hereby acknowledge they the said Commissioners have bargained sold and confirmed unto and by these presents do grant bargain sell and confirm unto Thomas Applewhite his heirs and assigns forever all that parcel or tract of land situated lying and being in the County of Southampton and on the North side of Thomas Applewhite's settl. parcel containing by estimation one hundred and fifty five acres be the same more or less and bounded by Thomas Applewhite on the East by Ambrose H. H. on the West together with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances thereto belonging To Have and to Hold the said tract of Land and all and singular the other premises hereby bargained sold and confirmed or intended to be with their and every of their rights as Commissioners unto the said Thomas Applewhite his heirs and assigns to the only proper use of him the said Thomas Applewhite his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Edward H. H. Benjamin Lewis and Samuel Drury as Commissioners well warrant and defend the premises aforesaid as Commissioners and further unto the said Thomas Applewhite his heirs and assigns forever against all and every person or persons whatsoever.
