This Indenture made this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of January or the Year of our Lord one thousand eight  
hundred and twenty six between James M. Gibson of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part  
of the said part and James M. Edwards of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part.  
Witnesseth that the said Edward Gibson for and consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty  
Dollars to him in hand paid by the said James M. Edwards he receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,  
that he has granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed unto the said James M.  
Edwards his heirs and assigns forever a certain Tract or parcel of Land situate lying and  
being in the County of Southampton State of Virginia bounded as follows. Beginning  
on the north side of Potoway River at the head of a Broad Branch or outlet from the main branch  
of said Branch or Valley to the Potoway river thence down the said main branch of said  
River to a series of three wills said line to a corner tree then along the way line to a  
corner on Thadach Vaughan's line thence along said Vaughan's line to a buckeye tree  
thence down said line to a corner stone in Potoway River thence along said river to  
the beginning containing by estimation one hundred and forty acres of land more or less being  
the same tract of land that Elizabeth M. Kee formerly occupied to have  
and to hold cheaply said Land all and sing where the rights profits and emoluments heretofore  
and apportioned of in and to the same belonging or otherwise appertaining to her  
proper use and behove the said James M. Edwards his heirs and assigns forever and the said  
James M. Gibson for his heirs executors and administrators covenant and agree to and with the said  
James M. Edwards his heirs and assigns that he before executing this and foregoing premises  
will warrant and forever defend against the right title interest or claim of attorney  
or persons whatsoever of the said James M. Edwards his heirs and assigns forever and the said  
James M. Gibson for his heirs executors and administrators set his hand and affix his seal
