This Indenture made this second day of February one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight  
by and between Albridge Jones of Southampton County and State of Virginia before whose part and behalf  
John Miller and Leonard Cobb of the same place inhabitants of Albridge Jones for and  
in consideration of one hundred dollars which he is appointed to him received by the  
said John Miller and Cobb before the date hereof and delivery of these presents doth accept in full of  
hereby acknowledged to be due Albridge Jones his said grant bargained sold and confirmed unto the above  
premises doth grant bargain sell and convey unto them the said lands situate at the bottom  
of South end of a Fishery known by the name of Sheep Stake formerly owned by Henry Adams  
from thence down the river to another cut distant from the first about five hundred yards &  
extending back fifty feet from the margin of the river the whole length of the beach or front but  
to quit to have and to hold the said Fishery or beach together with all the rents profits  
and convenient appurtenances belonging unto the said lands to the said James Garrison &  
Leonard Cobb their heirs and assigns forever and to the said Albridge Jones for himself  
his heirs and assigns wholly by these presents warrant and defend the said bargains premises  
against the lawful claim or demand of any person whatsoever to whom the said James  
Garrison & Leonard Cobb their heirs and assigns forever On Testimony whereof the  
said Albridge Jones has hereunto set his hand and seal this day of June 1828 Atton

This Indenture made and entered into this 15<sup>th</sup> May 1828 Between Prestley Barnes of the first  
part William Everett of the second part and John Gray of the third part all of the County of South-  
ampton in the State of Virginia U.S. witnesseth that whereas Prestley Barnes stands justly indebted to  
John Gray in the sum of one thousand and forty four dollars due by two Bonds bearing date  
with these presents, one for sixty nine dollars due and payable September next, the other for money  
five dollars due and payable the first day of November next and being desirous and willing to discharge  
the said debt unto him the said John Gray having this day for and in consideration of the premises  
and for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to him paid presently wherefore  
said William Everett the receipt whereof he hereby acknowledges granted bargained and sold  
and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto William Everett his representation  
&c the following property to wit one barrel horses one riding saddle one pannier & two bushels of  
furniture the whole of his crop of wheat, fodder and corn, except fifteen bushels of merchant-  
able corn unto him the said William Everett to be paid Prestley Barnes for himself his  
sons factors & agents debt remaining due forever defered upon true & mercantable as follows  
(In like manner) In the said William Everett being instructed by either of the parties after  
the first day of September next shall after giving fifteen days notice of the time and  
place proceed to sell at public sale so much of the property conveyed in this deed as shall
