This Indenture made and entered into this 27<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight by and between Lucy Parrell of the first part Augustino Topo of the second part and Henry Thomas of the third and last part all of said parties of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia whereat the said Lucy Parrell stands justly indebted to the said Henry Thomas in the sum of three hundred and six Dollars and twenty one cents by Bond bearing date with child Indenture payable on demand the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of November next together with the interest which may thereupon accrue if any which the said Lucy Parrell is willing and desirous effectually to assign and hand to the said Henry Thomas now therefore this Indenture is made in witness whereof the said Lucy Parrell as well in consideration of the premises aforesaid sum of one dollar current money of the United States to her in hand paid by the said Augustino Topo at and before the making and delivery of these presents the full receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and from every part of said the said Augustino Topo and all his legal representatives are forever released even created and discharged have granted bargained and sold and do hereby grant bargain and sell unto the said Augustino Topo his heirs and assigns as follows that is to say the said Lucy Parrell have granted bargained and sold and do hereby grant bargain and sell unto the said Augustino Topo his heirs and assigns all the interest accruing to her the said Lucy Parrell from the intermarrying of her the said Lucy with Giles Parrell it being that and the whole of that part of the Estate of Giles Parrell deceased which or will be assigned to her the said Lucy Parrell as her dower in the Estate of her late husband Giles Parrell consisting in Land and Slaves together with the following named articles of property (to wit) One small mare one dog and harness one bed and furniture one walnut table & China Pots which the said Lucy Parrell purchased at the sale of Giles Parrell deceased to have and to hold the said before named property and all things which she appropriate and thereunto in any manner belonging and all the right due interest and income of what ever or of what the said Lucy Parrell of or unto the same to her the said Augustino Topo his heirs Executors and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of her the said Augustino Topo his heirs Executors and assigns forever In Trust nevertheless that if the said
