This Indenture made and entered into the 22nd day of May in the year of our Lord 1828
between Burrnell Williams of the first part Samuel Kello of the second part and Seth P
Strong & Co of the third part all of the County of Surberien and State of Virginia the first part
that whereas the said Burrnell Williams stands justly to the said Seth P Strong & Co
by promissary note for the sum of Forty three dollars and forty eight cents bearing date
the 15th day of May 1828 the said Burrnell Williams having consents to discount and afford
to the said Seth P Strong & Co the amount of the aforesaid note amounting as aforesaid to the
sum of Forty three dollars and forty eight cents together with the legal interest thereon
accrued. Now this Indenture for the purpose aforesaid that the said Burrnell Williams
for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid as well the sum of one dollar to
him in hand paid by the said Samuel Kello, paid the receipt whereof the said Burrnell Williams
before the signing and delivery of these presents doth hereby acknowledge he hath granted
bargained and sold unto by these presents do grant bargain and sell to the said
Samuel Kello & his adm. the following property to wit 1 Sorrell mare 20 head of hogs
and 2 head of cattle and the said Burrnell Williams for himself his heirs & assigns
doth hereby covenant promise and agree to warrant and defend the right and title
of the aforesaid stock upon this special Trust and confidence that if the said
Burrnell Williams shall on or before the first day of June next pay to the said Seth P
Strong & Co. the aforesaid sum of money with the legal interest thereon according to the
this Indenture to be void but if on the contrary the said Burrnell Williams shall
fail in paying to the said Seth P Strong & Co. the aforesaid sum with interest thereon
the said Samuel Kello at the request of the said Seth P Strong & Co. or the said
Williams shall immediately proceed to sell at some public place within the County
designated by the parties hereto or a majority of them the aforesaid mare cattle & hogs
to the highest bidder for Cash Virginia money and out of the proceeds of said sale
first pay and discharge the expenses attending the execution of this Trust and then
pay and discharge the aforesaid sum of Forty three dollars and forty eight cents
with interest thereon to the said Seth P Strong & Co. or their representatives & if
any surplus should remain pay the same to the said Burrnell Williams his
heirs & Co. and the said Burrnell Williams further agreed to and with the said Seth P
Strong & Co. & Samuel Kello that he will at any time at the request of the said Seth
P Strong & Co. after the first day of June 1828 deliver to the said Samuel Kello the aforesaid
Stock for the purpose aforesaid and the said Samuel Kello agrees with the parties hereto
to do and perform what upon him these presents doth require for Testimony
whereof the parties hereto have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this
day and year first above written.
