This Indenture made and entered into this day of 15th May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight between John Warren of the first part and Peter Summers of the second part and John M'Quaart of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth that the said John Warren for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred four dollars and thirteen cents which said sum shall be paid from the said John Warren to the said John M'Quaart by bond bearing date the 19th day of May one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight and well as all other monies which may be due and owing from the said John Warren to the said John M'Quaart by means of any dealing transfer of debts or paper whatever as also for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Peter Summers the receipt whereof the said John Warren doth hereby acknowledge. hath given and bargained and sold and by these presents doth hereby grant bargain and sell convey and make over unto the said Peter Summers and his heirs forever all his right and interest in the following property (trust) one certain Tract of Land wherein the said John Warren resides containing one hundred acres and bounded Land of Benjamin French and others belonging to him the said John Warren to have and to hold with all the right and interest of the said John Warren herein contained or intended to be conveyed to him the said Peter Summers his heirs and assigns forever upon this Special Trust nevertheless that the said Peter Summers upon being directed required by the aforesaid John M'Quaart shall proceed to sell all the right and interest of the said John Warren to the above named property hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed after advertising the time and place in the said County of Southampton for ten days previous at some public house or store for cash and out of the money arising out of from the said sale in the first place pay and satisfy all costs attending the said sale as well as the expense attending the conveyance and then pay off the Bond aforesaid with interest as well as all other monies which may appear to be due and owing from the said John Warren to the said John M'Quaart by means of any dealing transfer of debts or paper whatever and then pay or satisfy of any John Warren who the said Peter Summers on his part warrants and agrees that he will release the said John Warren from the obligation of this indenture upon the said John Warren paying him the amount of the aforesaid Bond with interest as well as all other monies which may be due and owing to him from the said John Warren by means of any dealing transfer of debts or paper whatever the parties to these presents have agreed to set their hands ^{and seals} this day and year past above written
