This Indenture made the 25th day of January one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight by and between James D. Mapenburg Alfred Darden and Simon Murfee Commissioners for and in behalf of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and Schabro Johnson of the County and State aforesaid of the other part All to wit that the said James D. Mapenburg Alfred Darden and Simon Murfee Commissioners for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred and fifty three dollars and forty four cents to them in hand paid by them the said Schabro Johnson before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said James D. Mapenburg Alfred Darden and Simon Murfee do hereby acknowledge therein with date of content and paid have granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto him the said Schabro Johnson his heirs and assigns forever a certain Tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the lower part of Southampton County aforesaid containing by a late survey four hundred and four acres at being the tract of Land whereon the late William Edwards resided and which was sold by the above named Commissioners for a distribution among the heirs of said Edwards as follows: Commencing at a corner pine in Mt. Jones line thence along said line to Black Water road to Eliza Edwards line thence to 113 Edwards line thence to a brook then in Schabro Johnson's line thence to the first Station To have and to hold the said bargain promised with the appurtenances and advantages of all and every kind whatsoever to the said tract belonging to him the said Schabro Johnson and his heirs and assigns forever and they the said James D. Mapenburg Alfred Darden and Simon Murfee for themselves their heirs executors and assigns do and will warrant and forever defend the said bargain promised with the appurtenances aforesaid against the Lawful claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever claiming under the said Wm Edwards unto him the said Schabro Johnson and his heirs and assigns forever.

This Indenture made the 16th day of June 1828 one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight between Alexander Chapman of the County of Brunswick on the one part and Abel Waddell of the County of Southampton State of Virginia on the other part All to wit that the said Chapman for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and sixty five dollars to him in hand paid by the said Abel Waddell the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby bargain and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell to the said Abel Waddell his heirs and assigns a certain Tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Brunswick on the north side of White Oak Swamp containing by estimation one hundred and eighty eight acres of one half be the same more or less and bounded as follows Viz Beginning at a corner at the late a Black Gum on White Oak Swamp a corner for Edward Small and John H. Chapman thence up the same to the swamp to William Woolsey's Spring Branch thence up the said Branch a dividing line between said Land of the said Woolsey's Land to a new line lately made to a corner oak on said

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
