This Indenture made and entered into the 23rd day of Nov: 1827 between Diana Wynn
of Southampton County of the first part Her husband Peter Wynn second part and John J Mason of the
third part Whereas the said Diana Wynn and the said John J Mason have
just sum of four hundred and forty eight dollars Now due by bond of equal date heretofore made
between the said Diana Wynn and the said John J Mason and the said John J Mason is desirous
to secure the payment of the same And this Indenture is made in full
deal for and in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar to be hereinafter paid by
the said Peter and before the delivery and delivery of the said Peter to the said John J Mason
the said Peter has sold and delivered and by the said Peter to the said John J Mason the said Peter
the following negro slaves To wit Maria and her children to wit Emma
Edmund and Brown and Violet with their future increase To have and to hold to the said
John J Mason and his heirs forever upon Trust Nevertheless that the said Diana Wynn shall remain
possessor of the said slaves and their increase and to enjoy the profits of the same to wit the
said John J Mason or his heirs or assigns shall direct the said Peter in his life or term
to take possession of the same and after duly advertising the same and placing the same for
the said Peter as Trustee as aforesaid shall sell the said slaves and their increase as many of
may be necessary to satisfy the debt and interest aforesaid to the highest bidder for cash one
of the proceeds of such sale pay first the expenses of the said Trust which shall be paid
with the interest which may have accrued thereon and the balance of any sum to the said
Diana Wynn or her order but if the said Diana Wynn at any time before the
said sale shall have been made shall pay to the said John J Mason his heirs or assigns
the said sum of money with the interest thereon and the cost of heretofore the said
John J Mason covenants that the said slaves and their increase shall be fully paid to the
said Diana Wynn of this indenture and the said Diana for herself
heirs covenants that the said slaves shall be delivered for the purposes aforesaid
applied for In Testimony whereof the said Diana and the said John J Mason have hereunto set
their hands and affixed their seals the day & year first herein written
