This Indenture made the sixth day of February in the year eighteen hundred and forty eight between Albridgeon Jones of the County of Southampton Virginia of the first part and Wm M Jones of Lancaster County Virginia of the second part and Mary Croft of Lancaster County Virginia of the third part. WITNESSETH that the said Albridgeon Jones is justly indebted to the said Mary Croft in the sum of eleven hundred and eighty nine dollars and sixty four cents to be paid her or before the first day of March next ensuing at or before the day and year herein above mentioned which the said Albridgeon Jones is willing and desirous to secure more fully by the said William M Jones at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Albridgeon Jones hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Wm M Jones his husband assigns all the lands and appurtenances now in the occupancy of said Albridgeon Jones including the Ferry called Jones Ferry lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton and situated in the fork of a tributary of Black Water River and bordering on said River and also adjoining the lands of the late Jacob Darden and Septimah Darden Alexander Booth and the said Mary Croft containing twelve hundred & three acres more or less also two negro slaves namely Jacob and his wife together with all and singular the reversions & reversions remainders yearly and other rents, issues and profits therefrom and in part parcel thereof to have and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be granted tract or parcel of land with the aforesaid slaves unto the said Wm M Jones his husband assigns upon trust nevertheless that as soon after the default of the payment of the debt aforesaid as the said Mary Croft shall think proper or shall request by notice to the said William M Jones she shall proceed to sell the lands and slaves aforesaid to the highest bidder for ready money at public auction having first fixed the time and place of sale by three several advertisements one of which shall be posted at the door of the Court house of said County of Southampton on some one Court day previous to the day of sale and out of the monies arising therefrom he the said William M Jones shall first defray all the necessary expenses of the sale shall pay to the said Mary Croft his husband assigns the sum of Eleven hundred and eighty nine dollars and sixty four cents with interest thereon till paid and the balance if any he shall pay to the said Albridgeon Jones his husband assigns but if the whole of the said sum of Eleven hundred and eighty nine dollars & 64 Cents with interest thereon shall be paid off and discharged to the said Mary Croft on or before the first day of March next when the same is made payable so that no default of payment to make him Indemnity to be void due to remain in full force and virtue In witness whereof the parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year as first above written
