dred and twenty eight between Carr Powers and Sally Powers his wife of the one part
and Asahel Joyner of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of
Virginia witnesseth that the said Carr Powers and Sally his wife for & in consider-
ation of the sum of Five hundred and fifty dollars lawful money of Virginia to
them and paid by the said Asahel Joyner the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Asahel
Joyner his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in
the Parish of Tottenagh and County aforesaid containing by estimation one hundred and
seventeen acres to the same more or less the said tract is a residue of a tract of land purchased
of Joseph Tracy and wife by Jeremiah Edwards and sold by said Edwards to the said Carr
Powers as will be seen more fully by a reference to the several deeds recorded in the Clerks office
of said County and known as follows to wit by the terms of Matthew Mumford John
Moore Sally Barnes Charles Pitts and James Scotts wife unto together with all and
singular the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders of every manner and kind
of profits &c of any part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract
of one hundred and seventeen acres of land with the tenements hereditaments with every
of their rights & members and appurtenances unto the said Asahel Joyner his heirs and
assigns forever and the said Carr Powers and Sally his wife for themselves and their
heirs the said one hundred and seventeen acres of land with all and singular the premises
and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Asahel Joyner his heirs &
assigns free from all claim or claims of said Carr Powers and Sally his wife or
either of them alive or either of their heirs and of all and every person whatsoever
shall well and do warrant and defend by these presents In Witness whereof
the said Carr Powers and Sally his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals
