was acknowledged by said Amos Wicks and to gather with other certificates of the remaining  
most of documents annexed of Jolly Powers wife of said Amos Wicks and  
Amos Wicks admitted to record And at a court held for the County aforesaid  
the 18<sup>th</sup> August 1828 The said Indenture and certificate were acknowledged

Wicks Whereas it appearing that a certain contract was made between John Wicks & his wife  
to Edwin Vick in his life time for a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of South  
Wicks Southampton supposed to contain two hundred acres it being a part of the land that  
Amos Wicks had seized and allotted to the said Jolly Vick as and for his  
proportion in the same and although the contract was made between the parties  
yet no title to the said land was not made in the lifetime of the said Amos Wicks  
and the parties being advised that a legal title cannot be made without the inter-  
vention of the County Court whereupon a friendly tree was obtained  
compelling the said John Wicks and his wife to make a title to said land to the heirs  
of Edwin Vick in the fore mentioned indenture made this 27<sup>th</sup> day of July in the year  
of our Lord Christ 1828 Between John Wicks and Jolly his wife of the one part and  
John Vick and his wife of the other part who is now deceased leaving only  
one child for life as done in the name of the other  
part doth stipulate that the said John Wicks and Jolly his wife for and in consideration  
of the sum of five hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said John Wicks as a com-  
pensation of the said Vick the receipt whereof the said John Wicks & Jolly doth acknowledge  
doth acknowledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and paid in full for all  
bargains and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the heirs  
maneuvres of Edwin Vick a certain tract or parcel of land and premises  
lying and being in the County aforesaid and containing by estimation two hundred  
to the same more or less and bounded as follows (to wit) beginning at a post mark  
house a corner a corner in Margaret Vick's line thence NNE course along  
a marked tree to a corner a sagebrush thence NNE a line of marked trees  
to a corner a black pine in Jo. S. Vick's line thence said Vick's line ENE to a  
corner in Robert L. Simmons line a post oak thence a line of marked trees ENE  
corner in David Simmons line a pine thence NE a line of marked trees between  
Hinchion Williams and said Vick's a pine a corner thence NNE a line of marked  
trees between Henry Dwyer and said Vick to a post oak a corner from thence to the  
beginning together with all the houses out houses edifices buildings yards  
gardens ways waters and water courses profits commodities hereditaments and  
appurtenances to the said to the said lands belonging or in any way appertaining  
to the same to have and to hold the said land and premises as before mentioned  
And the said John Vick and Jolly his wife for themselves their heirs  
doth covenant and grant to the heirs of said Earl in Vick aforesaid tract of land before  
mention'd to them their heirs and assigns forever the right and title to the said  
land the said John Vick and Jolly his wife do warrant and convey for and against  
the claim of them their heirs assigns and against all and every other  
person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof
