The James Clayton and Benjamin Griffin Justices of the Peace for the County aforesaid and State of Virginia do hereby certify that Polly Nick the wife of John Nick parties to the within Indenture bearing date the 21st day of July 1828 for the conveyance of real Estate to Peggy Nick and her two infant Children personally appeared before us in our County aforesaid and being examined by us privately and apart from her husband and having the said aforesaid well explained to her she the said Polly Nick acknowledged the same to be her act and deed and declared that she had willingly signed sealed and delivered the same and that she would not retract it Given under our hands this 27th day of July 1828

This Indenture made this 25th day of July in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight between Allen Bradshaw of the first part and Garrison & Griffin Trustee of the second part Joel Bradshaw of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia do witness that the said Allen Bradshaw for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Garrison & Griffin at or before the executing and delivery of these presents do hereby acknowledge as well for the further consideration of the said Allen Bradshaw being justly in debt unto the said Joel Bradshaw in the just and full sum of seventy five dollars lawful money of Virginia which the said Allen Bradshaw doth acknowledge to have granted bargained sold conveyed and confirmed unto the said Garrison & Griffin one Bay horse four head of cattle nine head of hogs and one pair of cart wheels to be used and plantation utensils to be used to hold the said property within mentioned unto the said Garrison & Griffin his heirs Executors or assigns forever but upon this special Trust and Condition that the said Garrison & Griffin his heirs Executors or assigns upon being requested by the said Joel Bradshaw his heirs Executors or assigns after the 2nd of July in the year above mentioned that make sale of the said property at public Auction for the best price which can be obtained for the same after advertising the same and peace for selling the said property ten day previous notice to the day of sale at the Court house door of the said County and at as many other places as the said Garrison & Griffin his heirs Executors or assigns may think proper and with the money arising from the said sale shall first pay to the said Joel Bradshaw the sum of seventy five dollars with lawful interest from the date hereof until paid and the costs attending the said sale of the same then pay the surplus if any to the said Allen Bradshaw or his heirs Executors or assigns the said Garrison & Griffin his heirs Executors or assigns doth hereby warrant and forever defend against the lawful claims of what the said Allen Bradshaw his heirs Executors or assigns or any other person or persons whatsoever claiming or demanding the same or any part thereof which of the parties aforesaid have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals
