This Indenture made this 16th day of July in the year of our Lord Christ 1828
Between James Vasper and Polly his wife of thon part and John P. Mangrum of the
other part all of the County of Southampton Parish of Mottey & State of Virginia
Witnesseth that the said James Vasper and Polly his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth
to them in hand paid by the said John Mangrum at or before the executing of
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to have bargained
and sold and by these presents do each of them bargain and sell unto the said
John P. Mangrum his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land & premises
containing estimation twenty acres to the same more or less and bounded as
followeth Beginning in the Muskatannah Branch at a gum tree up a hilly
to a maple corner tree thence a straight line to a black horn in the rice Branch
a corner in old Linon's line thence down said Branch to said Katalannah Branch
thence down said branch to the beginning together with all and singular the
houses out houses edifices buildings yards gardens orchards land tenements &
woods underwood ways waters and water courses privileged for its commodities
admitted to hereditament and apportioned whatsoever to the said lands be-
longing or in any wise appertaining to the same or any part thereof or otherwise
belonging to the same or any part therof and every part and parcel thereof to
have and to hold the said acres of land with the tenements hereditaments
and singular other the premises herein before mentioned or interest to be
sold unto the said John P. Mangrum his heirs and assigns forever to him
for the only proper use of him the said John P. Mangrum his heirs and
assigns forever and the said James Vasper and Polly his wife his wife
for themselves their heirs the said land with all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said John P. Mangrum his heirs and assigns free from all claim
