Land of the County of Sussex and State of Virginia my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name to use to ask demand sue for recover and receive all such sums of money debts or any other property of any kind whatsoever which are or shall be due owing payable and belonging to me or detained from me by any manner of ways or means whatsoever giving and granting unto my said attorney by these presents my full and whole power and authority and full the promises to have use and take all lawful way means and in my name for the recovery thereof and upon the receipt of any such debts or sums of money or other property aforesaid acquitances or other sufficient receipts get for me and in my name to make seal and deliver for me and in my name that may be necessary to be done in and about the promises as fully and amply to all intents and purposes as myself might or could do if I was personally present. At Witnes my hand and seal the 1st day of June 1800 & twenty eight.
