thereof doth acquit the said Edward Reese his heirs and assigns hath
granted sold aliened Enfeoffed confirmed and made over unto the said Edward Reese
his heirs and assigns that Tract or parcel of Land ^{the} belonging to the Estate of Joseph
and Rivers Reese dec^d land lying in the County of Southampton and bounded by
the following lands to wit Beginning at a Stickory a corner of Thomas
Applewhite and David Prince and Sampson Reese thence along the said
Reese's line to Edward Reese's line thence along the said Reese's line to
David Prince's line thence along the said Prince's line to the beginning
containing one hundred and twenty six acres more or less to have and to
hold the said Tract or parcel of Land and all the singular improvements
thereunto belonging to him the said Edward Reese his heirs and assigns forever
and the said Drury Waller and Willie Francis Comrs doth for themselves
their heirs Executors and assigns covenant and agree to and with the said Edward Reese
his heirs and assigns against all and every person or persons whatsoever

This Indenture made the 15th day of May in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and twenty eight Between Robert Drury and his wife and
William Pitman of the County of Southampton of the one part and Joseph
Gardner of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Robert Drury and his
wife and William Pitman in consideration of the sum of four hundred and fifty
Dollars lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Joseph
Gardner at or before the executing and delivery of these presents (the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold and by these presents
do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Joseph Gardner
his heirs and assigns two certain Tracts or parcels of Land with
the appurtenances situate lying in the County of Southampton
and parish of Botolphay the one being the tract whereon John Norton
worthy sen^r deceased and his wife Mary formerly lived containing one hundred
fifty and half acres the half acre being reserved for the graveyard and the
other tract where Ann Salter dec^d formerly lived containing about one
