This Indenture made this twenty sixth day of June in the year of our Lord Eight hundred and twenty eight between Derry Waller and Willie Francis Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Southampton bearing date May term eighteen hundred and twenty eight of the first part and Edward Peese of the second part, witnesseth that the said Derry Waller and Willie Francis Commissioners for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and thirty two Dollars and twenty five cents to them in hand paid by the said Edward Peese at and before the sealing and delivery hereof he receipt whereof the said Derry Waller and Willie Francis both hereby acknowledge and doth acquit the said Edward Peese his husband and assigns hath granted sold alined Enfeoffed confirmed and made over unto the said Edward Peese his heirs and assigns that tract or parcel of land belonging to the Estate of Joseph and Rivers Pease dec^d land lying in the County of Southampton and bounded by the following lands to wit beginning at a Hickory a corner of Thomas Applewhite and David Prince and Sampson Pease thence along divers Peese's line to Edward Peese's line thence along the said Peese's line to David Prince's line thence along the said Prince's line to the beginning containing one hundred and twenty six acres more or less to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and all the singular improvements therunto belonging to him the said Edward Peese his heirs and assigns forever and the said Derry Waller and Willie Francis both for themselves their heirs executors and assigns covenant and agree to and with the said Edward Peese his heirs and assigns against all and every person or persons whatsoever In witness whereof we the said Derry Waller and Willie Francis Commissioners appointed to sell the said land have hereunto set our hands and seals the day and date above written

This Indenture made the 15th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight between Robert Derry and his wife and William Pittman of the County of Southampton of the one part and Joseph Gardner of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Robert Derry and his wife and William Pittman in consideration of the sum of four hundred and fifty Dollars lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Joseph Gardner at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents doth represent whereof is hereby acknowledged to have bargained and sold and by the said Joseph do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Joseph Gardner his heirs and assigns two certain tracts or parcels of Land with the appurtenances situate lying in the County of Southampton and parish of Bottomay the one being the tract wherein John Port-worthy son deceased and his wife Mary formerly lived containing one hundred and fifty and half acres the half acre being reserved for the graveyard and the other tract where Ann Salter dec^d formerly lived containing about one
