that for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to him in
hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged by the said Benj.
Williamson hath granted bargained and by these presents doth grant bargain
sell and conform unto the said Samuel Derry and his heirs forever one
certain tract or parcel of land situated and lying in the said County bounded on
the north by the three Creeks on the west by the lands of the said Derry
and John Derry on the South by the land of Humphrey Derry & Joseph
Derry including the whole of the land lately recovered in a suit brought by
the said Williamson as Executor of Arthur Williamson deceased against
the heirs of Joel Westbrooke deceased in the Superior Court of Southampton
containing two hundred and sixty three acres it to be the same more or less
with all the improvements and benefits thereunto belonging to have &
to hold unto the said Samuel Derry his heirs or assigns forever
which the said Land & the said Williamson do warrant and forever defend the right
title claim or interest unto the said Derry and his heirs forever against the claim or claim
of any person or persons whatsoever in whatsoever wherof the said
