thousand Eight hundred and twenty Eight between Benjamin Williamson of
the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and
Samuel Derry of the said County and State of the other part. Witnesseth
that for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to him in
hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged by the said Benjⁿ
Williamson hath granted bargained and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and confirm unto the said Samuel Derry and his heirs forever one
certain tract or parcel of Land situated and lying in the said County bounded on
the north by the three tracts on the west by the lands of the said Derry
and John Derry on the South by the land Humphrey Derry & Joseph
Derry including the whole of the land lately recovered in a suit brought by
the said Williamson as Executor of Arthur Williamson dec^d against
the heirs of Joel Westbrook dec^d in the Superior Court of Southampton
containing two hundred and sixty three acres it to be the same more or less
with all the improvements and benefits thereunto unto belonging To have &
to hold unto the said Samuel Derry his heirs or assigns forever
which the said Land the said Williamson do warrant and forever defend the right
title claim or interest unto the said Derry and his heirs forever against the claim or claim
of any person or persons whatsoever In Witness whereof the said
Williamson have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this day & date first

of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty Eight between Willed
Wellons of Southampton County of the one part and William Bony of the said
County of the second part and John Fivash of Sussex County of the third
part all of the State of Virginia Witnesseth that said Willed Wellons
being desirous of making the said John Fivash secure for the payment of
the sum of one hundred and fifty seven Dollars by Bⁿ Cont^d as ft Bond
and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar to him in hand paid by the
said William Bony the receipt is hereby acknowledged the said Willed
Wellons hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant
bargain and sell unto the said William Bony one negro boy named Sampson
To have and to hold the right title interest claim and demand of
against the said negro boy unto the said William Bony his heirs
admⁿ & assigns forever upon Trust nevertheless the said William Bony his heirs
