This Indenture made and entered into this eighteenth day of August 1828 between
Albington Jones of the first part Stephen Murdaugh of the second part and Spratley
Williams of the third part whereas the said Jones is indebted to the said Williams
in the sum of ~~four~~ hundred dollars due by bond bearing date with this present
and whereas also the said Spratley Williams hath become bound surety for him
the said Albington Jones on a promissory note coming to hand in execution from
Southampton Superior and County Court in favor of John & Son James
Merrick agent for Robert Myrick and James W. Deal for Bryant and as surety
on a bond to Doctor Thomas Smyer for about fifty odd dollars the precise amount
not recollected and is also bound as surety for him the said Jones in a bond to John B.
Watson for the sum of twenty five dollars and whereas the said Albington Jones is willing
and desire the payment of the said sum of money to the said Spratley Williams to
secure and is also willing to save him harmless and free from loss or damage by reason
of his several surety ships Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in con-
sideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said
Stephen Murdaugh he the said Albington Jones hath given granted bargained and
unto him the Stephen Murdaugh the tract of land whereon he now resides with the
Ferry called Jones's Ferry and two negro slaves to wit Jacob and Jack subject to an
incumbrance by deed of trust executed by the said Albington Jones to Wm Bond
for the purpose of securing the payment of a debt therein set forth to Hardy Bond
and he the said Jones doth also convey to the said Stephen Murdaugh his stock and thing
of three hundred eighteen head of cattle about forty five head of hogs also his growing crop of
Corn and Cotton and nine sheep and also his household and kitchen furniture to him
and his heirs forever Upon Trust nevertheless that the said Jones is to retain
possession of the said property until required by the said Williams to sell the same for
the said Stephen Murdaugh shall after advertising the same and sale of said property
said property as is herein conveyed as shall be necessary and sufficient to pay the said debt
with interest to the said Williams and also to pay the said several debts for which the said
Williams is bound as aforesaid and if the said Williams or Jones hath sold under the
deed to him aforesaid and any balance shall be in his hands after satisfying the purpose
of the said deed to him then the said Stephen Murdaugh is hereby authorized to receive
such balance from him and apply it to the purposes aforesaid In Testimony whereof
the several parties have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day & year above written
