other part. We therefore that the said Anselm Denson and Sally his wife for and in
consideration of the sum of one hundred and eighty eight dollars to them in hand paid or
secured to be paid by the said Hawkins Bond before the sealing and delivery of
these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and
sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Hawkins Bond his
heirs and assigns all their right title and interest in a certain tract or parcel of land
lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation seventy seven
acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands Thomas Hart, Isaac Bailey Jr,
Anthony Andrew and the said Hawkins Bond it being all the land which the said
Denson purchased at different times of John Washington dec^d and the reversion & reversion
remainder and remainders yearly and other rents, issues and profits thereof and every
part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract of land with all its tenements
hereditaments and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended
to be bargained and sold, and every part and parcel thereof with every of their right titles
and appurtenances unto the said Hawkins Bond his heirs and assigns forever and the said
Anselm Denson and Sally his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract of land
with all and singular the premises appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Hawkins Bond
his heirs and assigns free from the claims, claims of them the said Anselm Denson and Sally
his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs, executors, assigns and of all and every person
person whatsoever shall will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents.
