said William Lawrence in the just sum of twenty five dollar lawful money of
Virginia which appears by note executed by the said A. Gardner and Jesse G. Gardner
and made payable the 25th day of December 1828. now the said A. Gardner being desirous to
redeemify and secure the payment of the before mentioned debt but more especially for
the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said William Lawrence sr. before the
executing and delivering of these presents. Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged that the
said A. Gardner hath granted bargained and sold unto the said William Lawrence sr. two plantations
furniture one cart and wheel eight head of Cattle and all my Crops of every kind whatsoever now
growing to him the said William Lawrence sr. to him and his heirs forever upon the following trust
to wit that if the said A. Gardner shall fail to pay and discharge the above debt when it
shall become due it shall be the duty of the said William Lawrence sr. so soon as requested
in writing from under the hand of William Lawrence sr. to him and his heirs assigned to set up
sell for cash the before mentioned property or so much as will be sufficient to pay the debt
then due and pay to the said William Lawrence sr. the debt that is due to him with all costs
pertaining to this trust and the surplus if any pay over to the said A. Gardner his heirs
