Androm the To Androms. This Indenture made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
and twenty eight between Anthony Androm and Mary his wife of the County of Southampton of the one  
part and Lemuel Androm of the said County of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Anthony  
Androm and Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum of fifty Dollars & cents Lawful  
Money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Lemuel Androm at or before the  
making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained &  
sold and by these presents do and each of them with bargain and sell unto the said Lemuel Androm  
his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton  
Containing by a late survey 30 1/3 acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows Viz  
Beginning at a small pine a corner in Thomas Blais line thence along said Blais line  
N 17 M 89 poles to the large oak thence N 70 W 62 poles to a small maple in Jones line  
corner tree thence S 80 E 70 poles to a post or stick on ditch in said Androms line thence S 80 E 19  
poles to the head of lead ditch to a small black gum thence S 36 E 24 poles down lead ditch  
to a small black gum thence S 10 E 33 poles to a small Sassafras corner in line in  
Washington's line thence N 80 E 20 poles to the beginning together with all and singular  
the appurtenances thereto belonging and the reversions and reversions remaining  
remainders yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and of every thereof To  
have and to hold the said tract of Land with the tenements thereto annexed and all  
singular shops premises her in before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold  
unto the said Lemuel Androm his heirs and assigns forever and the said An-  
thony Androm and Mary his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract of Land  
with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said  
Lemuel Androm his heirs and assigns free from the claim of themselves the said
