This Indenture made this 10th day of September in the year 1828 between William Everett of
Southampton County of the first part and Thomas Harrison of Brunswick County of New Bern partibus in
state of Virginia witnesseth that whereas the said William Everett was made trustee to a certain indenture
executed by Benjamin Harrison to him for the purpose of securing the payment of sum of America
ten dollars and 54/100 cents to be paid by him due by note and on demand the 15th August 1828
as will fully appear by reference to the said record in the office of Southampton County such sum
as will be due and owing to the said Thomas Harrison his heirs &c such right and title as he
now has or shall have in and to a certain tract of Land lying and being in the County of
Southampton by containing by estimation two hundred and twenty acres to the same more or less
which Benjamin Harrison now resides or subject nevertheless to the payment of debt
trust executed by the said Benjamin Harrison to the said William Everett for the benefit of A. R. and
P. T. Musgrave on said Land as well more fully appears by reference to said record
unto the said Thomas Harrison and his heirs and I the said William Everett do warrant
defend such title as is vested in me by virtue of the above named deed in trust for further
as well as whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this day of date above written
