Jones executed a note to Jore Cobb for one hundred and twenty Dollars with said Calvert security and whereas the said Thomas C. Jones is desirous of securing and indemnifying said Thomas Calvert against any loss or injury by reason of said security ship, now and in consideration of the premises and the further consideration of one dollar current money in hand paid unto him the said Thomas C. Jones by the said James D. Mafentburg. the said Thomas C. Jones hath bargained and sold unto the said James D. Mafentburg one acre and more one sorrel horse all of his stock of cattle and hogs and cart and wheels. To have and to hold unto him the said James D. Mafentburg his heirs and assigns forever upon this special trust and confidence that he the said Thomas C. Jones shall keep possession of said property and enjoy the use of the same until such time as the said Thomas Calvert may require the sale of the same and then upon this further trust that the said James D. Mafentburg shall sell said property at public auction for cash and discharge the purposes of this trust with all accruing expenses and if any surplus pay the same over to the said Thomas C. Jones his heirs or assigns In witness whereof the said parties set their hands and seals this 18th day of September 1828.

WHEREAS that the said Miles Slade and Elly his wife for and in consideration of the just and full sum of One hundred Dollars current money of Virginia to him by the said James Cotton in hand paid the receipt whereof the said Miles Slade doth hereby acknowledge that grant and bargain and conveyance and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and convey unto the said James Cotton his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land containing forty acres be the same more or less siting and being in the County of Southampton and state aforesaid and in the state of Virginia the boundaries whereof will appear. To have and to hold the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said James Cotton his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said James Cotton his heirs and assigns forever the boundaries whereof as aforesaid will appear. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land as follows commencing at a small red oak on the South East which is first corner tree running then with David on the last side a north course and corner at a black gum and then round west corner joining Joseph Slade on the north to a post oak corner tree the same with ticks Spring line a South course to a white oak and corners at said ticks Spring line and Spring
