Know all men by these presents that Benjamin Turner of the said County and State for and in consideration of my regard for Sarah Clements the wife of Francis Clements and her children and for the further consideration of a Dollar to me in hand paid by William Everitt the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have this granted loaned and delivered unto the said William Everitt his representative of three feather beds & furniture unto him and his representative upon this special Trust nevertheless that the said William Everitt shall suffer the aforesaid Sarah Clements and her children to hold quiet possession of the three beds & furniture for her use and benefit only until the said Benjamin Turner may demand them from the said William Everitt whom it shall be lawful for him at all times when so demanded to take possession of and deliver the same to said Benjamin Turner or his heirs as witness our hands and seals this 23rd August 1828.
