hundred and twenty eight Between Joshua Johnson and Polly his wife of the County of South-
ampton of the first part and Mells Gray of the second part Witnesseth that the said
Joshua Johnson and Polly his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred dollars
to them in hand paid by the said Mells Gray at and before the ensuing and delivery hereof
the receipt whereof the said Joshua Johnson and his wife doth hereby acknowledge and
themselves doth acquit. the said Mells Gray his heirs executors and assigns hath granted bargained sold
and confirmed and made over unto the said Mells Gray his heirs and assigns forever all
that tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton Virginia and bounded
by the following lines to wit: Beginning at a red oak standing on the side of Barron's road
in John Nicholson's line thence about a North course to a white oak standing on a
bottom thence to a bay standing in a small branch thence to a pine marker for a shaft
thence to a white oak standing in John Turners line on the side of the South prong of
Puckhorn Swamp thence down the said Turners line to a white oak a corner of Elisha
Williams thence along the said Williams line to a pine at the road a corner of said Wil-
iams thence along the road to the first station containing fifty acres be the same more
or less. To have and to hold the said certain Tract or parcel of Land and all the im-
