To William P. Everitt of Southampton County Virginia Trustee of the one part and Benjamin
Williamson of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the other part Witness that
the said William P. Everitt Trustee in consideration of the sum of twelve hundred and
thirty one dollars of lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Benjamin
Williamson at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain
and sell unto the said Benjamin Williamson his heirs and assigns of the Tract or
parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and Greenville on each
side the Meherrin river on which Francis Clements now resides containing by estimation
Six hundred acres be the same more or less it being the Land purchased by Henry Harris
of John Bewick Trustee for Dr. Lucas and sold by the said Harris to Francis Clements
as well more fully appear by reference to the records of Southampton and Greenville counties
together with the said Francis Clements fee simple right in and to the same right held by him
in said tract of Land the houses and fenced orchards and all other improvements whatsoever
attached to the said Land and promised in any way to the said Francis Clements belonging to have and
to hold the said Tract of Land with the Tenements hereditaments &c. and all and singular the premises
herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof unto
