Know all men by these presents that we Albert Dremy Robert Dremy & Stephen Murdaugh are held and firmly bound unto William P. Giles Esq. Governor or chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the full and full sum of five thousand dollars to the payment whereof well and truly to be made to the said Governor for the term being and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 17th day of November 1828. The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Albert Dremy has been duly appointed by the County Court of Southampton to serve as constable in the said County in the superior district of Saint Lukes Parish until July Court next. Now if the said Albert Dremy shall well and truly discharge the duties of said ^{the} Office of Constable in the said County during his continuance therein then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.
