in and to the following slaves to wit one man named Melchior a woman named Phoebe
one named Rachel and one named Lucy and a girl named Lucy which said slaves
are held as slaves by Mrs. Emily Pierce formerly J. Briggs widow of Henry J. Briggs
during her life and at her death the above named negroes will belong to the said
to William & J. Briggs she and William & J. Briggs also hold equal interest
with his brothers and sisters being one female in the other negroes above mentioned
to the said Byrd Summer to have and to hold the said negroes and wife
at the death of the said Emily Pierce and one fourth share of the other negroes
above mentioned unto him the said Rice P. P. Pierce his Executors and Administrators and assigns forever
And I the said Byrd Summer for myself my heirs Executors and Administrators the title to
the above named negro slaves and the increase of the females thereof do hereby warrant & defend
unto him the said Rice P. P. Pierce his heirs Executors and Administrators and assigns
against myself my heirs Execs and adms by against the claim of all persons or persons
whomsoever. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my
Seal this 9th day of December 1828.
