I do hereby grant sell and confirm unto the said Rice P Pierce his Executors administrators & assigns forever the interest in which I derived by purchase from William W Briggs in and to the following slaves to wit one man named Mike one woman named Phillis one named Rachel and one named Per and a girl named Ceep which said slaves are held as dower by Mrs Emily Pierce formerly Briggs widow of Henry Briggs deceased during his life and at her death the above named negroes with belonging to the said William W Briggs the said William W Briggs also holds and equal interest with his brothers and sisters being one French and the other negro as above mentioned to the said Pyrrd Summer to have and to hold the said negro man Mike at the death of the said Emily Pierce and one French slave of the other negroes above mentioned unto him the said Rice P Pierce his Executors administrators and assigns forever And I the said Pyrrd Summer for myself my heirs Executors and administrators the title to the above named negro slaves and the increase of the same to them of to here by warrant & defend unto him the said Rice P Pierce his heirs Executors and administrators and assigns against myself my heirs Executors and assigns by against the claim of all persons or persons to whomsoever In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my Seal this 9th day of December 1828
