This Indenture made the twenty fifth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight between George Ponell and his wife of the state of North Carolina of the one part and George Tonome of the state of Virginia of the other part & witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars in hand paid the receipt whereof at herby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents doth give and sell unto the said George Tonome their undivided one eighth part of the land of which Nathan in Tonome the father of the said George died 21st August and he held containing three hundred eleven acres and a half acres by late survey to be the same more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton on the North side of the Helder Swamp well all and singularly with several rights including the dinner thereunto belonging which is hereby fully bargained and sold unto the said George Tonome persons free from the claims of all persons which said right the said George Ponell and Cynthia his wife do warrant and defend unto the said George Tonome and his heirs forever In Testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals the day and date above written.
