 harboring or entertaining him nor shall he compel her to cohabit with him or
 without her consent visit her or (living) come unto any house or place where she
 shall or may well reside or be nor without her consent send or cause to be sent
 any letter or message to her nor shall or well at any time hereafter claim or demand any
 of the monies household goods stock in trade or other property of what nature or kind or
 description so ever which she the said Michel now hath in her custody power or
 possession or which she shall or may at any time hereafter by or purchase or which she
