This indenture made this 12th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and twenty eight between William Griffin and Virginia his wife
 of the one part and Henry Lenox of the other part. Whereby it is shewed that the said William
 Griffin do and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty eight dollars
 to him in hand paid by the said Henry Lenox the receipt whereof
 the said William Griffin doth hereby acknowledge and shews this being said
 and paid one of the same doth by these presents acquit the said Henry Lenox they
 the said William Griffin have granted bargained and sold, aliened entered into
 confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and sell, alien entered into
 confirmed, the said Henry Lenox. Now certain tracts or parcels of land containing
 by calculation one of them thirty two and three fourths acres lying and being situate
 in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia bounded as follows Beginning
 at a pine in the survey branch thence down said branch to a gum 87 1/2 ft 10 1/2 ft
 to an oak on the path 88 1/2 ft 109 1/2 ft to a corner post oak in Lenox's line 92
 ft 40 ft to a corner pine a new chopped line tree on Lenox's thence along a line of survey
 trees S. 82 E. 32 ft. N 78 3/4 E 30 ft. N 85 E 33 ft. N 72 E 16 1/2 ft. E 12 ft. N 37 E 3 1/2 ft to
 the beginning containing 32 1/4 acres also one other small parcel of land adjoining
 the avenue containing seven 1/2 or there acres by a late survey and bounded as
 followeth Beginning at a corner pine in Henry Lenox's and Henry Gardner's line
 thence N 83 E 105 ft to a pine in Lenox's line thence N 85 E 105 ft to a pine stump in said line thence S 73 W 62 ft to the road thence N 79 E 30 ft. S 87 E 46 ft to a corner of Henry Gardner's in said road thence N 70 West 12 ft to the beginning containing seven and one half acres together
 with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or on any wise
 appertaining with the reversions and reversions therein and the same with
 heirs and assigns thereof and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold
 the said bargained premises with the appurtenances unto the said Henry Lenox
 his heirs and assigns forever and the said William Griffin for himself
 him his Executors & assigns the said bargained premises and every part and
 parcel thereof with all their appurtenances clear exempted secure from
 his heirs and assigns against all and every person or persons who shall or shall not
 claim or shall by these presents forewarned and defend he to his heirs assigns
 the said William Griffin and Virginia his wife her heirs and assigns
