articles of agreement

Articles of agreement made and entered into this 10th day of September in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty eight between William Phillips of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Abolom P. Smith of the County of Norfolk and state of North Carolina of the other part Abolom Smith that whereas William Phillips now deceased the father of the testator William Phillips departed this life some years since having previously executed his last will and testament wherein he gave and devised the whole of his Estate both real and personal that is to say his wife Caroline Matilda at present the wife of the said Abolom P. Smith of the second part and to his son William Phillips of the first part and others all of which will more fully appear by reference to the said last will and Testament of the said Testator which is preserved and remaining record in the County of Southampton and whereas the said William Phillips and the said A. P. Smith for aforesaid being perfectly satisfied with the said last will and Testament of the said William Phillips the 2^d and desirous to render it perfectly just and binding between the said Phillips and said Smith to whom the Testator therefore witnesseth that the parties named for and in consideration of the premises and for the further consideration of one dollar to each by the other respectively in hand paid before the execution of this agreement to commence contract and agree that the said Will of the said William Phillips aforesaid during his said property both real and personal to the said persons herein named and given to his executors in the said Will of the said William Phillips now deceased and formerly of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia shall forever remain valid and binding between the parties hanc scilicet and mother of the said parties nor their executors administrators or assigns & shall ever make any claim or demand or demands whatsoever either of the other parties his heirs Executors administrators or assigns for any part whatsoever of the property so aforesaid and devised in the said last will and Testament of the said William Phillips aforesaid to such persons as are mentioned and given in said Will as aforesaid and that the said William Phillips doth further agree and bind himself his heirs Executors administrators or assigns to release with all rights and title intensions claim he has or ever did have if any to all of the legacies and property given and devised to Caroline A. Phillips now Caroline A. Smith the wife of the said A. P. Smith given her by the said last will and Testament of the said William Phillips aforesaid and do by these presents warrant and for ever defend the right and title to the said before mentioned property to the said Abolom P. Smith to him his heirs and assigns forever against the claim or claims or demands or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever and the said A. P. Smith for himself his wife Caroline and himself to stand to and abide by the said last will and Testament of the said William Phillips aforesaid In Testimony whereof the parties have affixed their names and affixed their seals to this covenant and agreement this day 2^d dated first above written
