This Indenture made and entered into this twenty second day of November eighteen hundred  
and Twenty Eight Between Allor Edwards John Edwards James Moore in right of his wife Margaret  
James Murfie in right of his wife Elizabeth Allor Edwards Common Law Guardian for the heirs of  
Anthony Wells deceased and James Wills of the other part witnesseth that he said Allor Edwards,  
John Edwards James Moore in right of his wife Margaret James Murfie in right of his wife  
Elizabeth Allor Edwards Common Law Guardian for the heirs of Anthony Wells deceased in con-  
sideration of one thousand dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid  
by the said James Wills at or before the sealing and delivery of this present Indenture bargained and sold  
and by these presents do and each of them doth buy and sell unto the said James Wills a certain  
tract or parcel of Land being the tract purchased by James Edwards in right of the estate of Henry  
Briggs Beginning near the head springing thence along a line of marked trees on James Henry's land  
thence along James Wells' and Mrs. Stephens' and Mrs. Summers line to the west corner thereof  
thence down the same to the east thence down the east side Beginning  
together with the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders yearly and other issues and profits  
and every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold said tract of Land with the tenements  
hereditaments and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intimated to be  
bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof whether of them by themselves and  
appurtenances unto the said James Wills his heirs and assigns forever And the said Allor Ed-  
wards John Edwards James Moore in right of his wife Margaret James Murfie in right of  
his wife Elizabeth Allor Edwards Common Law Guardian for the heirs of Anthony Wells  
deceased for themselves and their heirs and executors and administrators of the said Allor Edwards  
the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said James Wills his heirs and  
assigns free from the claim of the said Allor Edwards John Edwards James Moore in right  
of his wife Margaret James Murfie in right of his wife Elizabeth Allor Edwards Common

of all and every person whatsoever shall demand so warrant and process sent by the proper

Law Guardian for the heirs of Anthony Wells deceased shall have and hold the same  
afforesaid tract of land undisturbed for ever written
