This Indenture made this 15th day of December Between Robert Gordon Commissioner
 appointed by the County Court of Southampton to make sale of the Land wherein Richard Blon
 or did dig and possessed (and which said tract of Land was by the last will of
 said Richard Blon devised to be sold, at the death of sell^r Mary Blon and the
 process of the sale to be equally divided between the sons of Henry Blon one) of the
 one part and James and Henry Blon of the other part all of the County of South-
 ampton and State of Virginia Witnesses that whereas the County Court of Southampton
 at November Court 1828 pronounced a decree directing that Robert Gordon aforesaid
 should make notice of the time and place make sale of the above mentioned
 Land on a certain day two and thirty years except the amount of expenses attending the
 sale of said Land which was to be made in cash and whereas the said Robert Gordon
 Commissioner as aforesaid in pursuance of the decree aforesaid did on the 15th of
 December 1828 expose the aforesaid Land to public sale on the before mentioned
 Credit except the expenses attending the sale which was to be paid in cash three
 weeks public notice of the time and place of sale having been first given and the
 said James and Henry Blon became the purchasers at the price of seven hundred
 hundred dollars. This he certifies therefore further witnesses that the said
 Robert Gordon Commissioner appointed by the County Court of Southampton
 for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid but more especially for satisfaction
 of the sum of Eleven hundred and eighty seven dollars in bond one of
 1827 8/8th and the 15th of December 1829 one other of the same sum due the 15th of
 December 1830 and a third one due the 15th of November 1831 for the sum and
 payable to Robert Gordon guardian of Samuel Blon and three other Bonds of
 the same amount and due at the same times payable to Robert Guardian of
 Robert Blon. The said Robert Gordon Commissioner as aforesaid here grants
 bargains and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the
 said James and Henry Blon the aforesaid tract of Land containing as well appa-
 red by reference to the Commissioner's Book Seven hundred and fifty six acres
 more or less the boundaries may be known by reference to the record of
 this office To have and to hold the aforesaid Land to the said James and
 Henry Blon their heirs and assigns and the said Robert Gordon Com-
 missioner as aforesaid for himself will only grant such right as is vested
 in him as Commissioner aforesaid In Testimony whereof the said Robert
 Gordon has hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year
