Between Elizabeth Britt of the County of Norfolk and state of North Carolina of the one part and Mills A Britt of the County and state aforesaid son of the said Elizabeth Britt as well for and in consideration of his natural love and affection which she had and beareth unto the said Mills A Britt her son also for the better maintenance and perform^t of the said Mills A Britt her son granted unto her self and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant alien Enjoyn and confirm unto the said Mills A Britt one certain parcel or part of a tract of Land which lyes in the County of Crumhampten and state of Virginia to certain two hundred acres and so to be laid off as to include the dwelling house and all the out houses which is attached to the dwelling house the south part of Land out of which the two hundred acres to be laid off containing (two hundred and twenty) three acres and better and bounded as follows on the North side of Nolton River and the same but and the Land of the Trust of Henry Haverward Goodrich Cobb and Eliza Gardner on the following terms the said Mills A Britt doth agree on his part to provide and support the said Elizabeth Britt and Sallye A Britt the daughter of the said Elizabeth Britt with a debt support for them during the life of the said Elizabeth Britt with all and singular debts and burthens and all things out houses lands & what may be included in the said two hundred acres of Land and all the Estates right to be interest property claim and demand whatsoever of the said Elizabeth Britt of or unto the said two hundred acres of Land and to except and have all these of with the appurtenances and all deeds witnesses and writings concerning the said premises only and in the hands of Custody of the said Elizabeth Britt or which he may get or come by without suit in Law To have and to hold the said mortgage or tenements lands and premises hereby given and granted or mentioned or intended to be given and granted unto the said Mills A Britt his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of them the said Mills A Britt his heirs and assigns forever and the said Elizabeth Britt for herself her heirs Executors and administrators doth Covenant and grant to and with the said Mills A Britt his heirs and assigns by these presents that he the said Mills A Britt his heirs and assigns shall and lawfully may from thence forth for ever thence forth peaceably and quietly have hold occupy possess and enjoy the said mortgage tenements lands here with all rights and premises hereby given and granted or mentioned or intended to be given free from the claim or demand of any person or persons whatsoever in all things whereof I have Curato ad my hand and seal this day and date before written signed sealed and acted as for act and do do goers
