This Indenture made and entered into on the seventh day of January in the year of our
Lord Eighteen Hundred and twenty nine Between Benjamin Jordan late of the County of Solomons
Richard Jordan all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Joseph Jordan of the
County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Jordan late of the County of Solomons
Joseph Jordan the said Jordan and Richard Jordan for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars and in money
25th day of February 1830 of this Commonwealth to them or have had by the said Joseph Jordan as or before their sealing and
delivery of this indenture the receipt whereof they acknowledge to have granted bargain and
sold and by these presents they and each of them doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Joseph Jordan his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel
of Land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint
Puke's containing by estimation one hundred and twenty of more or less the same more or less
it being the land and plantation whereon the said Joseph Jordan now resides and bounded as
followeth to wit Beginning at a Black gum standing near the corner of the Richm Swamp a
corner for Sally Dick in Lewis Morris line thence along said Sally Dick's line of mas-
sive trees to a post oak a corner for William Hargrove and others thence along
said John Hargrove's line of massive trees to a Black gum standing in one prong of
the upper Richm Swamp a corner for Benjamin Jordan thence along his line to a Black gum
standing near the mansion of said Richm Swamp a corner for said Benjamin Jordan and Lewis
Morris line thence down the line of said swamp the various courses thereof particularly stated
to wit with all the borders and fences now, or water and water courses and all right title
claim or demand of men and to the said tract or parcel of land and premises to be appurte-
nances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold the aforesaid
tract or parcel of land and premises with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging
unto them the said Joseph Jordan his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper
use and behoof of them the said Joseph Jordan his heirs and assigns forever and the said
Benjamin Jordan late of the County of Solomons Richard Jordan and Richard Jordan for themselves
